

## Uniform Dress Code

It is our belief that good dress and work habits reflect a proper school attitude. Students are required to be in proper dress code during school hours and on field trips unless otherwise notified. Students who do not comply with the dress code will face consequences set by our school discipline policy.

### *Grades K-6 Dress Code*

#### **Girls K-3:**

- White or burgundy knit polo shirt
- Burgundy plaid jumper
- Burgundy sweater/vest
- Black dress shoes (no gym shoes)
- White, burgundy or gray tights or socks

#### **Girls 4-6:**

- White or burgundy knit polo shirt
- Burgundy plaid skirt, burgundy plaid skort, or dark gray slacks
- Burgundy sweater
- Black dress shoes (no gym shoes)
- White, burgundy or gray tights or socks

#### **Boys K-6:**

- White or burgundy knit polo shirt
- Dark gray pants ***with a black belt***
- Burgundy sweater/vest
- Black dress shoes (no gym shoes)
- Solid color socks

#### **Gym Uniform:**

- Burgundy or gray sweats or shorts (sweat pant legs **MUST** be worn at ankle length)
- White t-shirt
- White gym shoes – permitted only on gym days
- White gym socks

**Gym uniform may be worn on gym days *only* during the school year for grades K-6.**

**THE FOLLOWING ITEMS ARE NOT ALLOWED TO BE WORN IN SCHOOL**

- No sunglasses
- No tank tops or tight fitting tops
- No jeans
- No hooded sweatshirts
- No visible body piercing including bandaids covering piercings
- No rollers/curlers
- No hanging belts
- No jackets
- No key cords
- No combs or picks
- Stud earrings (in ears) are **acceptable for girls only. Boys may not wear earrings.**
- No pants may be worn under skirts (for girls). *Pants may be worn under skirts in winter only, but must be removed once in school.***
- No boots** – hiking, work boots, etc. may be worn during the school day. *Boots may be worn to school during the winter, but must be removed once in school and regular school shoes put on.*
- No hats** or other head coverings, including sweatbands and handkerchiefs are permitted.
- Hair **cannot** be colored or highlighted any color that is not a natural hair color.
- No designs of any kind are permitted in the hair or eyebrows.** (eg. Mohawk, twisties and/or braids for boys)
- Necklaces **must** be tucked inside shirts or blouses and must be a reasonable size
- No sandals
- No sleeveless shirts
- No large hoop/ dangling earrings  
(for safety reasons)
- No sagging pants
- No visible tattoos
- No hair glitter/body glitter
- No hanging suspenders
- No shorts (non-uniform)

**Students are expected to be dressed and groomed in a manner which will not be disruptive to the educational process, constitute a health or safety hazard or violate civil law. All shirts are to be worn inside the pants, skirts, or shorts at all times.**

***Any clothing or jewelry that is distracting to the learning process is not permitted.***

**\*\*Final determination of appropriateness of student dress and measures taken to enforce the policy will be made by the School Director.\*\***

Uniform clothing may also be purchased at the following stores (except for the girls' uniform jumper and skirt): Target, Wal-Mart, Sears, This Is It, Dennis Uniform or the school.
